STAFF ACTION IN CASE OF ACCIDENT OR ILLNESS ON THE EXCURSION

Students' Health/Medical/Parent contact details forms and necessary medications will be taken on the excursion.

NOTE:

Staff accompanying students on excursions will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities. Parents/guardians should be aware that staff members are not responsible for injuries or damage to property which may occur on an excursion where, in all circumstances, staff members have not been negligent.

In the case of excursions not involving an overnight stay, costs incurred as a result of accident or illness are the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

The school camp/excursions insurance policy applies for approved camps/excursions involving an overnight stay. The policy covers students to a maximum of \$10,000 for medical and ancillary expenses where Medicare or private health insurance does not cover these costs.

Parents are required to inform the organisers well before the scheduled excursion departure of any change to their child's health and fitness so that appropriate supervision can be arranged. Where it is considered necessary, school staff will arrange medical assessment and treatment for students.
