

Contributions and Charges 2024



The Yokine Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2024.

1. Voluntary Contributions - \$60 per student

Voluntary contributions are set in accordance with School Education Regulations 2000.

Money collected is used to supplement school expenditure by purchasing resources for priority learning areas.

2. Digital Technology and Building & Grounds Improvement Contributions

Yokine PS Digital Technology Contributions

This fund was established and sanctioned by the School Board in 2012 to allow parents and community members to donate to support the school to develop the Kindergarten – Year 6 digital technology initiative. This investment continues to support our direction in building the capacity of technology integration across the school.

Yokine PS Grounds Improvement Contributions

This was established and sanctioned by the School Board in 2014 to support the establishment and maintenance of our grounds and play, and enhance the delivery of best practice learning programs.

The School Board has included the option for parents to make an additional voluntary contribution to these funds by paying \$10, \$20, \$50 or any other amount. Donations can be made at any time during the year.
